JANUARY

MARCH

1. Man's right to Dominate is by Creation. Created in the likeness and image of God. *Gen. 1:26*

2. The Power of the Holy Spirit is one of the Believers Most Valuable Assets. *John 16:7-11*
3. Knowledge received without the illumination of the Holy Spirit leaves the natural man incarcerated in his mind. *2 Timothy 3:2-7*
4. Do not accept conclusions about your future based upon past or historical information. *2 Corinthians 5:17*
5. Get out of your mind; stop walking by what you see. *2 Corinthians 5:7*
6. The natural man is governed by perceptual (sensory information, i.e. see, hear, touch, taste, & smell) and conceptual (education, reasoning, & historical) knowledge.
7. The Spiritual Man sees and speaks those things that are not seen to the natural eye as though they were. For he is Holy Spirit inspired. *Rom 4:17*
8. The Holy Spirit of God is given so you can see the things God has given to you. (To get you out of your mind) *1 Corinthians 2:12*
9. If you can see it - it is already done. *1 Corinthians 2:9*
10. Be mindful of God in you. "...I will never leave you " *Heb. 13:5b*
11. Walk in the Spirit – See yourself obedient, healed, delivered, and prospering in every area of your life. *3John 2*
12. To be carnally minded is to be against God. God is Spirit and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth. *Rom 8:6-8/John 4:24*
13. Renew your mind in the word of God. *Rom 12:1-2*
14. Think on those things that are true, honest, pure, and lovely and of a good report. *Phil 4:8*
15. We are in the world, but not of the world. *John 17:14-16*
16. He that sows to the spirit shall of the spirit reap life. *Gal. 6:8*
17. Set your mind on things above. *Col 3:2-5*
18. God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love and a sound mind. *2Tim. 1:7*

31. Eyes have not seen nor has it entered into the heart of man the things God has prepared for those who love Him. *1 Corinthians 2:9* (Get out of your Mind!!!)

APRIL

1 Be strong in the Lord and the power of His might (Eph 6:10)

2 “Seize yourself”

3 The joy of the Lord is your strength and fullness of joy is in His presence. (Neh 8:10, Ps 16:11)

4 Strengthen yourself and find something to rejoice about.

5 There is no condemnation in those that are in Christ Jesus!

7 It is the anointing that destroys the yoke!

22 Today I choose to get out of my mind; I will not stay in the incarceration of my natural mind. I see only the prepared things God has revealed to me by the Holy Spirit. (1 Corinthians 2:10)

23 Today I escape the incarceration of the historical circumstances of my mind by the power of the Holy Spirit through the revelation and inspiration of the Word of God. (1 Corinthians 2:11)

24 Today I choose to partner with people who are out of their mind, speaking only what is revealed by the Spirit of God. (Matthew 18:19, 20)

25 By the power of the Holy Spirit, today I choose to allow God access to my marriage by teaching me to be the vessel of love and strength to uplift and encouragement His child. (Ephesians 5:22-33)

26 Today by the power of the Holy Spirit the wisdom of God guides me and the protection of God surrounds me. (Ephesians 5:15, 16)

27 Today I go forth to all nations and by the power of the Holy Spirit that flows through me; many souls are reconciled to God. (Luke 24:47)

28 Today I rejoice! The Spirit of God dwells within me and I keep His commands, He loves me, and has manifested Himself to me. (John 14:21)

29 Today I take my stand as a son of God, and in the nature, character and authority of God I take dominion on earth. (John 16:23)

30 With a joyful heart I set my course. My goal is fulfilling my purpose. My expectation is to put a smile on the face of my Lord and hear “well done.” (John 16:24)

MAY

Day 1 **Luke 24: 49**

Behold I send the Promise of My father upon you: but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high.

- I may not be an impressive vessel, but I am a ready vessel.

Day 7 **Acts 8: 26**

Now an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip, saying, "Arise and go..."

- Today, the Spirit of God is leading me to the right place and point to make a powerful impact.

Day 8 **Acts 8: 30**

So Philip ran to him, ...and said, "Do you understand what you are reading."

- By God's assistance through the prophet, I understand the word from God.

Day 9 **John 14: 26**

But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name,...

- Today, I receive the help of the Lord. I have divine assistance from the Holy Spirit.

Day 10 **Acts 8: 31**

And he said, "How can I, unless someone guides me?"...

- Today, I am confident that with the assistance of the Holy Spirit I can help someone understand Christ.

Day 11. **John 16: 13**

...for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak.

- I confidently accept what the Holy Spirit hears and speaks.

Day 12 **Acts 8: 35**

Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this scripture, preached Jesus to him.

- At the unction of the Holy Spirit, I go to give a word.

Day 13 **Acts 8: 36**

...And the eunuch said, "See, here is water. What hinders me from being baptized?"

- Today, I am divinely positioned to lead another to Christ.

Day 14 **2 Corinthians 4: 18**

While we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen,...

- I am in faith that sees beyond what is apparent. I clearly see what God has for me by revelation of the Holy Spirit.

Day 15 **Acts 8: 35**

Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this scripture, preached Jesus to him.

- Today, I go to the house of God looking for whom I can help.

Day 16 **Job 32: 8**

There is a spirit in man, and the breath of the Almighty gives him understanding.

- Today, I am fully inspired by the Spirit of the Almighty with life and understanding.

Day 17 **Acts 2: 38**

...and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

- I possess all the manifestations of the Holy Spirit because I receive the gift which is the Holy Spirit. As He wills, the Holy Spirit articulates these manifestations through me.

Day 18 **Luke 9: 1**

Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases.

- As a result of my restoration to my God-intended state from creation, I have been given authority over demonic presence and influence.

Day 19 **Acts 8: 26**

"...go towards the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." This is desert.

- Today, I can follow God through barren and dry places and find increase and deliverance.

Day 20 **Acts 2: 10**

But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit...

- I receive revelation from God internally through my connection with His Spirit, and not just from the prophet.

Day 21 **John 16: 13**

However when He, the Spirit of truth is come, He will guide you into all truth;...

- I am out of my mind and into my spirit. I follow the Spirit and I am led into all truth.

Day 22 **Acts 2: 10**

But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit...

- When I am in the presence of the prophet, I often rejoice for confirmation of what the Spirit has previously revealed.

Day 23 **2 Corinthians 4: 17**

For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory.

- It may look like a mess now, but through the Holy Spirit, I can see the weight of glory on the other side of this.

Day 24 **John 16: 13**

However when He, the Spirit of truth is come, He will guide you into all truth;...

- Through the leading of the Holy Spirit, I grasp the reality that lies at the base of what is apparent.

Day 25 **Isaiah 53: 1**

Who has believed our report?...

- I believe the report of the Holy Spirit.

Day 26 **John 14: 27**

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you...

- Today, I will not allow my mind to be crippled by anxiety and fear. I receive the peace of Jesus Christ by His Holy Spirit

Day 27 **John 10: 30**

I and My Father are one.

- Today, through the Holy Spirit, I am at one with God. We are united in purpose, will, and perspective.

Day 28 **Luke 8: 50**

But when Jesus heard it, He answered him saying, "Do not be afraid; only believe..."

- I have been inspired by the Holy Spirit. I will no allow my natural circumstances to cause me to become fearful and limited.

Day 29 **1 Corinthians 2: 9**

Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared...

- My spirit is open to the Spirit of God. I am free from the conceptual prison of my mind and the influence of my natural perception.

Day 30 **2 Peter 1: 3**

as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness...

- I do not worry about what is going to happen in my life. My God has seen to it that I am equipped with all things for vitality and power.

Day 31 **1 Corinthians 2: 9**

...which God has prepared for those who love Him.

- God has prepared some things for me. This realization sets me at ease in all my daily endeavors.

18.

Pray for your family today!

Pray that the will of God be done on earth as it is in heaven today!

Pray so that the promises of God will be manifested in your life!
